

Community Kashering 2025

Chief Rabbi Wieder will be available to kasher utensils for Pesach.

What utensils can be kashered for Pesach?

- · Utensils made from metal, wood, stone, composite stone or plastic can be kashered.
- · Utensils made from earthenware, ceramic, porcelain or china cannot be kashered.
- · Utensils made from glassware and Pyrex should not be kashered.

For example:

- · Stainless steel and cast-iron pots can be kashered, but ceramic or enamel-coated pots cannot.
- · Most cutlery and kitchen knives can be kashered.
- · Most hot-water urns can be kashered.
- · Most plates, bowls and dishes cannot be kashered.

Utensils should be cleaned thoroughly and not used for 24 hours before kashering.
